North Shore Baptist has been participating for many years, providing a place to get a cup of cold water, use a restroom and enjoy some delicious food prepared by the 4 congregations that share this building: Hispanic, Karen from Burma/Myanmar, Japanese and English Language. I invite you to try these wonderful foods early as we generally sell out by 1pm!

This year we have decided to celebrate the talents of our family, friends and neighbors by hosting a Crafts & Vendor Fair. Our hope is offer a good variety of handmade, locally made items. We will try very hard to keep the show fair and consistent. It is our desire to have this show primarily represent area crafters and artisans, more than importers, stores or manufactured items. I will do my best to place everyone, however, it is the sole discretion of North Shore Baptist as to whom we accept and where we place people. Please note that we will not accept items that include profanity, violence and vulgarity.

Your \$35 donation is tax deductible to the extent allowed by law and is non-refundable. (Last year's participants will note that this is a reduction from the previous amount of \$50 per space.) Proceeds will benefit the Mission Projects undertaken by North Shore Baptist Church. All crafters and vendors will be accepted in the order that the applications and payments are received.

Set-up time will be from 7:30-9:00am with the Fair running until 2:30. Clean-up must be completed by 4:00pm. One caveat: parking is very limited but available. The entrances at Lakewood and Berwyn are handicap-accessible. With apologies, please be aware that no extra help is available to assist you in moving your items.
